PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

CLASSIFYING: Classes will be decided at show move in by the judging staff. Classes will be divided by type of entry and degree of modifications according to the 2010 SOKA Classification and Guideline Book. All Entries must start and move on their own power in which it will then receive a sticker on the headlight. Please review the 2010 SOKA Showcase of Kustoms Classification Book available on our website at www.LBMOTORAMA.com or call us at 714-846-7121 to order yours today!

JUDGING: Your vehicle will be judged by a team of judges, based on detail, quality, workmanship, condition, safety and originality.

FIRE REGULATIONS: Fire regulations require locked or taped over gas caps, with no more than 1/4 tank of gas showing on gas gauge or in tank. Battery cables must have a master cut-off or be disconnected and taped. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials (no straw, grass, bark, flares or any other type of flammables allowed in display).

SHOW CARDS: Cards will be furnished for Vehicle I. D. and proof of identity for receiving your award. They must be in your display at all times.

DISPLAY: To enhance the appearance of your exhibit, we ask all entrants to furnish their own rock salt, angel hair (or other simulated effect), carpet, flooring, and creative stanchions & rope. If you cannot furnish your own stanchions & rope, we will furnish them but you must let us know on your registration form.

8. Exhibitor agrees to obtain insurance covering exhibitors vehicle, trailer, display and all belongings. The exhibitor assumes full responsibility for any loss or damage.

10. Entries must be postmarked by deadline date. Not responsible for lost materials.
11. Please provide 3/4 front, 3/4 rear, engine, and interior photos with this application. Photos become the property of Keen Entertainment and may not be returned.
12. Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 fee plus the original amount of the check.
